

Area Company Fined \$71,400

OSHA issued 17 serious and 12 other-than-serious safety violations to an area company for failure to develop and implement a monitoring plan for workers exposed to high noise levels; not develop procedures to prevent machinery from starting up unexpectedly during maintenance and servicing; not providing personal protective equipment to workers; and for not training employees who operate forklifts. The employer was also cited for exposing workers to fall hazards and moving parts on equipment that was missing safety guards.

Quote: "This company failed to protect its full-time and temporary workers from a wide range of safety and health hazards that could result in serious injury or death," said Les Grove, OSHA's director of the Tampa Area Office. "Employers cannot wait for an OSHA inspection to identify these hazards. It's good business to implement preventative programs and systems to identify and correct such hazards as part of day-to-day operations."

Proposed penalties: \$71,400



First Aid/CPR

This nationally recognized American Safety & Health Institute First Aid & **Adult CPR training course helps** employers comply with OSHA's requirement for trained First Aid responders (29 CFR 1910.151). It is geared specifically towards response to workplace injuries, illnesses and includes OSHA required Blood borne Pathogens training for employees with potential exposure to blood or body fluids. Upon successful completion, participants earn a 2-year First Aid/CPR certification and documentation for Blood borne Pathogens is provided to the employer.

OSHA requires all Powered Industrial Truck operators to receive both Formal and Practical training before being permitted to operate the truck (29 CFR 1910.178). This course provides basic, formal training on the topics listed. The employer may then train the operator on truck and site specific hazards and complete the practical or hands-on evaluation, using the handy checklist provided.


